Last month we had fun...exploring the fascinating world of plants and animals through hands-on learning and play. We've looked at plant and animal lifecycles, talked about what living things need to grow and thrive, and even discussed the differences between living and non-living things. We've been comparing the sizes of plants and animals, using new vocabulary such as bigger, smaller, more, and less, while also recalling and sequencing our journeys to school. In our Personal, Social and Emotional Development, we've focused on effortful control, turn-taking games, and building empathy by understanding the needs of animals and plants. The children have enjoyed planting wildflowers and cress, and our roleplay garden centre has been a wonderful space for imaginative play, encouraging conversations about planting, growing, and looking after nature. It's been a busy month!





#### In June we will be...

Asking —. What journeys have we been on? Where might we go on holiday? Where might we go after Pre-School?

Reading – The colour Monster goes to School, Tyrannosaurus Drip, Rosie's Walk

Singing – 5 little men in a flying saucer, Look! There's a Dinosaur!

**Exploring** — Our feelings. We will be exploring our feelings and talking about what make makes us feel happy, sad, angry or worried.

**How can you help** — Take time to talk to your child about journeys you are going on and the different transport you might use. Point out different buildings and different points of interest when you travel.
